Notes and Instructions for Applicants

1. Introduction

The BEVA Trust Travel Scholarships are awarded to encourage members and associate members of the British Equine Veterinary Association to visit appropriate establishments or to attend overseas training courses in order to undertake study related to the science and welfare of the horse.

2. Eligibility and Purpose of BEVA Trust Travel Scholarships

These scholarships are NOT currently available to students. (Veterinary students may apply for the BEVA Trust Queen Mother Student Travel Awards.)

These awards are typically made to BEVA members with less than 10 years of equine clinical experience and are open to all members including Interns and Residents.

The awards are strictly for economy class travel costs and additional expenses such as course fees, bed and breakfast accommodation.

A scholarship will typically not exceed £1250.

The applications will be assessed and the award made by the BEVA Trustees.

The Trustees will assess applications against evidence within the application of:

- a) The importance of the proposed training to the applicant.
- b) The intended outcomes of the training and how these will impact on clinical service provision within the applicants practice/institution.
- c) The quality of structure/planning of the proposed period of training.
- d) The standing and reputation of the host institution/practice.
- e) A financial justification e.g. why The BEVA Trust rather than the individual or her/his employer should fund the training visit.

3. Conditions of BEVA Trust Travel Scholarship

The awardee will be required, on completion of his/her travel, to prepare a written report not exceeding 3000 words. The completed report must be made permanently available to the Trustees in digital format within 6 weeks of completing the travel.

The Scholarship is tenable for 12 calendar months from the date of the award. The closing dates for applications are 1st May and 1st November annually on completion of a Travel Scholarship Application Form.

Successful applicants are not eligible for reapplication. The award will not be granted if travel has already taken place.
