1. Introduction

Queen Mother Student Travel Awards will be awarded to enable student members of the British Equine Veterinary Association to travel in order to expand their studies relating to the science and welfare of the horse.

2. Eligibility and Purpose of Queen Mother Student Travel Awards

The awards are intended to assist towards costs associated with visiting a centre of excellence either in the UK or overseas. The award will only be made on confirmation that the applicant has been accepted by such a centre of excellence and if the student is a current member of BEVA.

Awards will typically not exceed £1000. Awards are for economy travel costs and additional expenses, such as bed and breakfast accommodation.

The applications will be assessed and the award made by the BEVA Trustees. The Trustees will assess applications against evidence within the application of:

- a) The importance of the proposed training to the applicant.
- b) How the outcomes of the training will impact on the career aspirations of the applicant.
- c) The quality of structure/planning of the proposed period of training.
- d) The standing and reputation of the host institution/practice.
- e) Any additional circumstances felt relevant.

3. Conditions of Queen Mother Travel Award

The awardees will be required to prepare (within 6 weeks of travel) a written report not exceeding 2000 words. The completed report must be made available to the Trustees in digital format and the report may be placed on the BEVA website. An annual award of £150 will be made for the report ranked highest by the Trustees.

The Scholarship is tenable for 12 calendar months from the date of the award. The closing date for applications is 1st May and 1st November on completion of a Queen Mother Student Travel Award Application Form. Successful applicants are not eligible for reapplication. Awards will not be granted for visits that have already taken place at the time of application.
